Spiritual lectures aim first and foremost to a better understanding of oneself in his relationship with his environment, with his neighbour and with God.

Each one of us has his own beliefs, convictions and experiences on which he builds his peace, joy and happiness. It's through God's intervention, in particular, through crisis, that one becomes aware that everything should be put in the melting pot. SaintPaul found himself at a turning point on the road to Damascus just like his ancestors three centuries sooner, but the other way around.

Saint Paul's peace had been threatened all of a sudden by a handful of ignoramus fishermen, preaching God's offering of peace and salvation to humankind, through the incarnation and the atonement sacrifice of his Son on the cross.

Saint Paul's experience provides us with an opportunity to rethink our faith and relationship to God by rebuilding them on a new basis.
